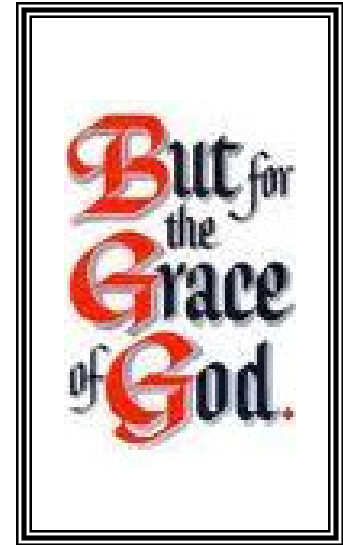
The Still Suffering Alcoholic Needs Your Help!


